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Breastfeeding for infants with epilepsy and ketogenic diet therapy

Ketogenic diet therapy (KDT) is safe and effective for the dietary

management in epilepsy. Significant seizure reduction is more common when KDT is used early and for specific epilepsy syndromes and aetiologies. Complete weaning from breastfeeding is **not required** to implement KDT. However, breastfeeding remains uncommon. Barriers include feasibility concerns and lack of referrals to expert centres.

Practical strategies are conducted to help mothers and professionals overcome these barriers and facilitate the inclusion of breastfeeding and human milk during KDT.

Dr. Elles van der Louw will guide you step by step through the key points and recommended strategies from the clinical practice guideline.
